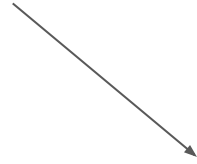

Transition & Advising

At the heart of College Unbound in the inside and outside is the centrality of an advisor who works closely with the student throughout their career.

- Meet with currently enrolled students on a frequent basis to track progress
- Identify students and former students who will be released within 6-12 months
- Work in collaboration with the DOC to better understand the student's needs as they are getting ready to transition outside
- “Walk with them” as soon as they get out
